O.H.C.C. RANGE RULES

- FOR MEMBERS & GUEST ONLY!
- GUEST MUST BE WITH A MEMBER.
- NO MEMBER OR GUEST LESS THAN 21 YEARS OF AGE MAY POSSESS OR USE A HANDGUN ON CLUB PROPERTIES OR RANGES UNLESS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A MEMBER WHO IS 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAWS.
- NO MEMBER OR GUEST WHO IS LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE MAY POSSESS OR USE A RIFLE OR SHOTGUN ON CLUB PROPERTIES AND RANGES UNLESS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A MEMBER WHO IS 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAWS.
- NO SHOOTING WHEN TENANT IS WORKING HIS FIELD BEHIND BACKSTOP.
 - ALL SHOOTERS MUST DISPLAY MEMBERSHIP CARD if REQUESTED.
 - CHECK FIELD BEHIND BACKSTOP.
 - ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS IS TO BE USED AS TARGETS.
 - TARGETS CENTERED ON BACKSTOP and MINIMUM 2 FT. OFF GROUND.
- SALVAGE SPEND BRASS and CLEAN FIRING POINT and BACKSTOP.
- ANY NON-MEMBERS, NOT WITH A MEMBER MAY BE SUBJECT TO PROSECUTION.
- MEMBERS VIOLATING RANGE RULES MAY BE SUBJECT TO CLUB REGULATIONS and PENALTIES!
