Terry Rudes reports on May 18, 2012, the OHCC sponsored a Junior Rifle event for 9 new junior shooters from the U.S. Navy Sea Cadets Program located in Port Clinton and Cincinnati. All of the new shooters were given instruction on firearms safety and were required to memorize the NRA 3 rules of safe gun handling. Three of the first time shooters scored 100% on the range shooting part of the event.

The Sea Cadets have a smallbore team consisting of **Cadets Johns, Brown, Gill, Rumbutis, and Frey** who have been training with the OHCC Junior Rifle Program and will be competing in the ORPA Ohio Outdoor Smallbore Regional Prone match at Camp Perry in July.

The new shooters were coached by the smallbore team members in the prone position, loading, and basics of firing an accurate shot. The perfect scorers challenged the smallbore team members to a shoot off fun match before calling it a day.

The cadets were supervised by several of the program leaders **LtJg. Donald Rumbutis, XO; LtJg. Stephanie Kemper, Medical Officer; Ens. Jacob Mills, Personal Ops; Inst. Angel Cunningham, Administration** from **USNSCC Firelands Division** with cadets. **Lt. Lusk** from **USNSCC Cincinnati Division** with cadets.

OHCC Junior Rifle Instructors and **Coaches Terry Rudes** and **Richard Rudes** conducted the event.
