### Voids

- Voids must be done within 3 hours of sale, at terminal that issued license.
- Cannot void if terminal has been uploaded since sale.
- Voids are done by transaction, not by license. If sale contained multiple licenses, all will be voided and you must return all issued licenses.
- Voided licenses must be returned to the DOW within 60 days to ensure proper credit.
