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OHIO WATERFOWL SURVEY

The online survey can be accessed by the link listed at the bottom of this page. The State Of Ohio believes the background information provided here will be helpful for you to read BEFORE you take the survey. Individual respondents are limited to taking the survey 1 time. This survey is designed to gather public input from Ohio waterfowl hunters regarding the use of hunting ZONES as a tool to set duck seasons within Ohio in future years. This survey is not about the timing / season dates used within any ZONE. Public input on season dates will be gathered separately in the future.

State Wildlife Agencies, like the Ohio Division of Wildlife, have the opportunity once every 5 years to establish, change, or eliminate ZONE BOUNDARIES associated with waterfowl hunting.
