DARR WETLANDS - Dan Pittman reports the tree planting has been completed on Hellmann's Hollow.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR DOG TRAINING ETC. : Please note that use of the Darr property is restricted due to nesting of pheasants, ducks, geese, and other game until July 15. Then, any use should be only after contact **with Dan Pittman (419) 862-2759**, to coordinate users of the property.

BIRD SURVEY AT THE DARR WETLANDS - The Oak Harbor Conservation Club has been contacted by the Ohio State University School of Environment and Natural Resources in Columbus. The University is organizing a state-wide bird survey to be conducted between the beginnings of May through the end of June this year. The goal of this project is to determine the distribution of eight bird species (rails, bitterns, coots, moorhens) across the state during the breeding season. Surveys occur during the hours surrounding sunrise and sunset when birds are most vocal. A technician would need to walk to the point from the road and perform a 15 minute listening survey, marking down any kinds of birds seen or heard during that time. They will be on the Darr Property site three times (once every two weeks) over the survey period (May-June).

Camp Perry Air Gun Range Open For Public Shooting . Shooters, including aspiring new shooters, who live in the Camp Perry, Ohio area are invited to take advantage of a new opportunity to do practice shooting on Tuesday evenings at the Camp Perry Marksmanship Center air gun range. The Camp Perry 80-point 10-meter air gun range is fully equipped with electronic targets that accommodate air rifle, air pistol or National Match Air Rifle shooting. The Ottawa County 4-H Shooting Sports Club uses one-half of the range every Tuesday evening for junior three-position air rifle shooting. School-age juniors are welcome to join this group. The range will now open for public air rifle and air pistol shooting by adults starting on **Tuesday, 24 February***. The range is open from 5:30 PM until 8:00 PM every Tuesday evening. All shooters who use the range must complete a CMP Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Waiver (one-time only) and attend a short safety briefing. Depending upon staff availability, arrangements can be made to provide instruction to new shooters. The cost for adult shooting at the Marksmanship Center is \$5.00 per day, it is \$2.00 per day for juniors (high school aged). Shooters may bring their own air rifles or air pistols (must be .177 cal. with muzzle velocities of 600 fps or less). Sporter class air rifles (Daisy M853) are available as loaners at the range. Shooters should supply their own pellets or may purchase them at the range. In order to facilitate range staff planning, anyone who would like to shoot on Tuesday evenings is requested to send an email message to vdonoho@odcmp.com stating when you would like to come to the range.
