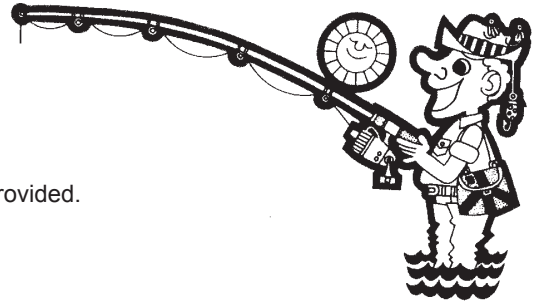
All kids must be accompanied by an adult. Bring your own poles, but bait will be provided.
