MEETING NOTES: Trustees. President Rudes announced changes in the clubs purchasing and reimbursement procedures. Purchases for club will be made by President Rudes utilizing the club's accounts to avoid duplication or need for reimbursement to multiple individuals. Individuals who make purchases without prior approval will not be reimbursed by the club.

To improve and standardize reporting for club activities and facilitate auditing, activity report forms and vouchers for reimbursement or payment club activities will be provided to all committees and will be required to obtain payment for expenditures. The provided forms will allow the committee or event chairman and treasurer to ensure that payments are made from the correct line items in the budget and insure that grant money expenditures comply with the grant limitations.

Trustees voted to approved the sale of lead ingots to club members for \$1.00 per pound. The lead will be available on Friday evenings from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. or contact John Scharding at 419-862-2335 or jscharding@aol.com Purchases must be by check or money order payable to the OHCC.

Trustees passed a motion to require all committees intending to spend more than \$500 from their budgeted line items for an event to have a scheduled committee meeting within a 90 day period prior to the expenditure of the funds with minutes and attendance reported.

Range Rules Reminders: Range use is on a first come/first serve basis. Feel free to ask someone using the range if you can shoot with them. The person firing the closest to the back stop **is the firing line**. Do not handle firearms behind the firing line or when anyone is down range, including packing or unpacking. **Never** sweep anyone with the muzzle of your gun, **always** keep the muzzle pointed into the backstop or ceiling. All damage to range, negligent discharges into ceiling, walls, area above the backstop, or damage to the wooden target holders must be reported to the Chief Range Officer immediately. 419 732-3000 or trudes@cros.net Be able to account for all of your shots.
