## MEETING NOTES: Trustees.

President Rudes appointed **PAUL DORNBUSCH** as public relations chairman. Paul will see that the webpage, facebook, and Chamber of Commerce postings are timely updated. Thanks Paul for volunteering. The treasurer announced that a new format was being used for the financial reports for the trustees meetings. The new format provides the increases and decreases in line items to make tracking easier. President Rudes announced that the budget committee will meet on July 3, at 7:00 p.m. to draw up the C-3 and C-4 budgets for 2020. If you are a committee chair or interested, feel free to attend and to get you requests to the committee. Committee is composed of the 4 officers and members David Oldberg and John Schroeder.

John Brikmanis, Constitution and By-law chairman, reported out the constitutional amendments and by law changes proposed last month by John Duncan. The constitutional amendment to eliminate the spousal discount has been placed on the agenda for the annual meeting in October. The 2 by-law amendments were approved for consideration at the general meeting.

**General Meeting:** The membership voted to authorize the expenditure of up to \$2,000 for stone to put in a drive onto club property at the Darr off of Duff Washa Road. Thirty two members were present to vote on the by-law changes. After discussion of each proposal, the membership voted. The members voted unanimously to approve the proposal to amend the meeting agenda from "may" to "shall." The membership voted 29 to 2 to reject the proposal to eliminate the senior and disabled membership dues discounts. **THANK YOU** to all the members who attended. **RICHARD Rudes** reported that OHCC Jr. Rifle Shooter **ALLISON SCHULTZE** competed in 2 smallbore 3200 rifle matches. In Marengo, Ohio, ORPA State Match, Allison was unclassified and thus shot in Master class (highest level) and tied 3 time world champion (OHCC member) **KEVIN NEVIUS** in 2 stages, and won high junior after 2 days of shooting with a score of 3169-196. Kevin Nevius won the match with a score of 3194-238. Great job **ALLISON** and **KEVIN**. In Bristol, IN., 3200 prone regional match, **ALLISON** came in first in Sharpshooter/Expert Classification in 3 of the 4 matches and on day two shot 2 first place and a 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Allison was handicapped by only using iron sights and still shot respectable scores on the matches where scopes were allowed.

Tuesday Steel Matches. Starts at 5 p.m. until finished. Do not have to be there at 5, shoot when you get there. \$5.00 entry fee. Course of fire is 5 targets at 10 yards +/- shot for time. Shoot course of fire 5 times and the 3 best scores are counted. Classifications are: **Unlimited:** Any gun with adjustable sights, optics or red dot, laser sights, ports or compensators, competition triggers or trigger jobs, extended mag wells. **Service:** Firearm cannot have any of the previously mentioned features. **Carry:** Firearms is a compact or smaller and cannot have any of the previously mentioned features of an Unlimited class. **.22 Rimfire:** Rimfire guns may have adjustable sights, optics or red dot, laser sights, ports or compensators, competition triggers or trigger jobs, extended mag wells. Enter multiple classifications. Prizes.
