## MEETING NOTES: Trustees.

Trustees authorized President Rudes to obtain estimates for upgrading the ventilation system on the 50 yard range. Trustees also authorized the widening of the outdoor range by approximately 25 yards to allow for installation of dirt wings on each side of the range without impinging on the derby pond. This is part of the ongoing improvements to the outdoor range. President Rudes is asking members with equipment or skills that could help in the improvements to contact him. Anyone having fill dirt or stone to donate would be appreciated.

The budget committee approved C-3 and C-4 budgets for 2020 and the trustees voted to place the budgets on the agenda for the annual meeting.

The re-write of the constitution and by laws was discussed and approved as an item of business for the annual meeting. The constitutional amendment to eliminate the spouse discount had previously been placed on the agenda for the annual meeting in October.

Trustees approved several dates for **defensive pistol classes** to be conducted by Richard Rudes. July 20, Sept. 28, Oct. 26, Nov. 23, and Dec. 14. Times and cost will be announced. Classes will be open to the public as well as members. Previous classes have been highly praised.

**General Meeting:** The membership voted to authorize the expenditure of up to \$2,000 for stone to put in a drive onto club property at the Darr off of Duff Washa Road. Thirty two members were present to vote on the by-law changes. After discussion of each proposal, the membership voted. The members voted unanimously to approve the proposal to amend the meeting agenda from "may" to "shall." The membership voted 29 to 2 to reject the proposal to eliminate the senior and disabled membership dues discounts. **THANK YOU** to all the members who attended. This is your club and you do have a vote.

**Unlimited:** Any gun with adjustable sights, optics or red dot, laser sights, ports or compensators, competition triggers or trigger jobs, extended mag wells. **Service:** Firearm cannot have any of the previously mentioned features. **Carry:** Firearms is a compact or smaller and cannot have any of the previously mentioned features of an Unlimited class. **.22 Rimfire:** Rimfire guns may have adjustable sights, optics or red dot, laser sights, ports or compensators, competition triggers or trigger jobs, extended mag wells. Enter multiple classifications. Prizes.
