Meeting Happenings

The 2026 Budget was presented and discussed. The budget is providing for block funding for the committees to reduce micro managing of the committees. Reserve accounts are being established for anticipated major purchases or repairs. The budget will be voted on by the membership at the annual meeting.

Several bylaw and constitutional amendments have been proposed.

A discussion was held regarding the clubs savings and investments. A large part of the funds came from the contract that the OHCC had with the Department of Natural Resources as the county agent for the sale of hunting and fishing licenses. During a good part of the contract period the Darr did not even exist.
