Volunteers are needed for several things at the club. March Meeting: Trustees approved the appointment of committees and positions submitted President Rudes.

Three constitutional/bylaw changes have been submitted on the Constitution Committee forms.

1. By member Terry Warner. Any person who wants to run for an officer position must have served a term as a trustee prior to being a candidate. This provision will not prevent the president from appointing a person to fill an officer position if no candidate has run for the position or the position is vacant.
2. By member Terry Warner. The business at the annual meeting will be provided to the membership as provided by the constitution in advance of the meeting. Membership will be verified by treasure at the beginning of the meeting. Members may then obtain a ballot for the candidates, budget, and any issues or constitution/bylaw changes and vote. Members are not required to stay for the rest of the meeting.
3. By member Steve Kessler. The trustees can provide for voting by electronic means or obtaining ballots prior to the annual meeting for those who are not able to attend the annual meeting. The ballots must be returned to the club on or before the annual meeting so they can be counted. Ballots arriving after the annual meeting will not be counted. The ballots must be completed by the individual member. Ballot harvesting is not allowed and such ballots will not be counted. Each ballot, other than those case at the annual meeting will be signed or verified by the member.

Amendments to the Range Rules were approved. The amendments to the Darr Rules were approved. A discussion was held regarding the 20 hour work requirement or payment of \$200 in lieu of the work hours violated the by laws section on dues. The work hours or payment is required to hunt the Darr and are above the information provided on the membership application.

The trustees approved a contract for the lead removal on the ranges with MT2. The work will be scheduled and the membership notified.

The Port Clinton Police Department will be using the ranges for qualification during the days the first week of June. There are no conflicts with other events or programs.

The trustees approved a motion to allow the club to conduct raffles with the proceeds being earmarked by the sponsor of the raffle.

Inventories of the club's property have been completed, but not yet turned in. There has not been an inventory in years and were needed for insurance purposes and in case there is a loss to substantiate our loss. Thanks to Mike Gargac, David Witt, Richard Rudes, Keith Kralik, and Mrs. David Witt.
